


Michael Zacharia is Co-Director of the Pacis Project on Faith Based Diplomacy and Adjunct Professor of Law at the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution at the Pepperdine University School of Law. He retired in July 2007, as Executive Vice President for Business Development. General Counsel and Secretary of DFS Group Limited, Michael Zacharia the world's largest travel retail company, in order to

enroll full time in the LLM program at the Straus Institute. In 1988, Michael was appointed by President Reagan and confirmed by the Senate, as Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Export Administration. Prior to that. he served as Special Assistant in the office of the United States Secretary of State.



Mosab Hassan Yousef is the author of Son of Hamas, a New York Times bestseller, Mr. Yousef was born the son of the spiritual leader of Hamas, a terrorist organization founded to destroy Israel. While he completed his undergraduate degree in history and geography, the insight he gained from living as a spy with access to the top leadership in the midst of one of the world's greatest conflicts was something few people will ever experience.



Mr. Yousef has traveled throughout the United States sharing his insight on the Middle East conflict, including how his friendship with Israelis is proof that Jews and Muslims can work together. At the podium, he exposes events and processes that, to this point, have been known only by a handful of individuals and reveal new information about the world's most dangerous terrorist organization. Yousef unveils the truth about his own role, his agonizing separation from family and homeland, and his belief that to "love your enemies" is the only way to peace in the Middle East.



We'll explore how religious radicals dominate their message and how various religions handle dissent and extremism. We'll share a panel discussion touching upon the impact of the radical fringes, as well as the positive force religion brings to our world.
